

SURVEY- regarding students interested for placement in Germany

As per Punjab Govt. instructions, the PNRC is conducting survey that how many students are interested in placement / internship / working in Germany. All the Principals of the Nursing Colleges are requested to do a session with the students of B.Sc. Nursing 2nd year and B.Sc. Nursing 3rd year regarding this opportunity and get filled “**Performa A**” from these students individually. Then, The Principal (through its Nodal Officer appointed for this Project) needs to fill the consolidated information in the “**Performa B**” and email it to PNRC at registrarpnrc@gmail.com by 13th Dec. 2019, (4:00 pm) positively. The detailed information and performas of this survey are as below:-

Information of the general process for the nursing students if they are interested:

- You will need to learn German language proficiency level B2 to work in Germany
- After completing B.Sc. you can get a 6 months probation work in Germany on a job seeking visa after which you will get a permanent job.
- After working for 3 years, you will get a permanent residence status in Germany.
- At the end of another 3 to 5 years, you will qualify for German citizenship.
- First 6 months of probation would get you a gross salary of approximately €1200 per month.
- After 6 months, your gross salary could go up to €2300 per month.
- Depending on your performance and further study/specialization earnings could further go up to €3500 per month.
- Once you have permanent immigration you are allowed to work in all 27 Countries of the European Union.

Outline Note

As you are aware there is a huge shortage of nurses in Germany due to an aging and retiring healthcare workforce, which will only increase year on year. It is estimated that by end 2020, Germany would require 84,000 additional nurses to cover its shortfall. The German Federal Government has taken upon itself to modify the immigration law to make the entry of qualified nurses easier. This presents a tremendous opportunity for B.Sc. nursing graduates from Punjab to work and live in Germany with guaranteed jobs with a Permanent Residence status which after a maximum period of 8 years would qualify them for citizenship.

To work as a nurse in Germany, proficiency in German language at the level of B2 is mandatory. This is a standardized 3 part exam consisting of writing, listening and speaking modules at each level i.e.: A1, A2, B1 and B2. This can be achieved by a very intensive 32 week German language learning program, which ideally should be spread over 104 weeks/24 months considering that will be in addition to their ongoing nursing studies. Ideally the German language lessons should start not later than the beginning of the 2nd year. For an early success of the program, one could start with the current new entrants into the 3rd year so that by the time they finish their 4th year they are completely proficient and have successfully completed B2.

Once students have cleared the B.Sc. Nursing degree program and the German Language test at B2 level, they will qualify for getting a "job seeking visa", on the basis which they will travel to Germany. This of course is based on the assumption that we will succeed in getting recognition from the German Nursing Institution, after they have audited and approved the Institutions in Punjab, which will follow the curriculum that is agreed by them. When the degree equivalency is established, the nurse will apply for a job-seeking visa at the German Embassy in New Delhi.

Upon arriving in Germany, nurses will be received and housed and send to future employers for a probation work period of up-to 6 months. During this probation work, nurses will be paid a gross salary of approximately 1200 Euros per month. After the 6 month probation period is over, the gross salary could go up-to 2300 Euros per month. Depending on their performance and further studies/specialization in Germany, their gross salary could even go up-to 3200 Euros per month.

After working for three years, nurses will get a Permanent Resident Status in Germany. (This Permanent Residence status is not job linked which allows nurses to work anywhere in the EU.) After another three to five years of working in Germany, they will be entitled to full German citizenship with the opportunity to live and work anywhere in the 27 EU countries.

Nurses are highly regarded and very well respected and there is complete gender neutrality in this profession in the West/ this is a life changing opportunity for young nurses from Punjab. With their German nursing experience, they will find it easy to work and live in countries like US, Canada, Australia, UK etc.
